Credits earned at previous high schools, adults schools and colleges can be counted towards your diploma. Students will work on only the credits needed to complete requirements. A transcript from the last high school attended is required.

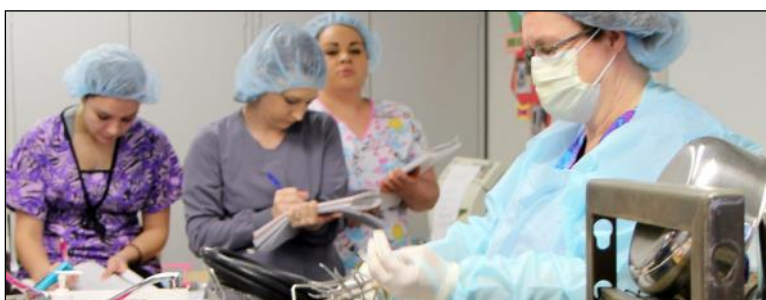
