Welcome to the 2019-20 school year!

Child Nutrition Services is pleased to provide Breakfast and Lunch each school day to all students; ensuring they are fueled up and ready to learn. We offer nutritious meals that meet or exceed state and federal nutrition guidelines. Students are required to use their student identification number for breakfast and lunch, as well as take ½ cup fruit and/or vegetable to accompany their entrée of choice.

This packet includes:

- Meal application for free or reduced price meals
- Meal prepayment information

Meal prices:

- **BREAKFAST IS FREE TO ALL STUDENTS THIS YEAR**
- Elementary/K-8 school lunch \$2.75
- Middle/High schools lunch \$3.25

The District Meal Charge Policy is as follows. It has been approved by the California Department of Education and is in alignment with the law.

- Students are allowed to negatively charge meals (breakfast and/or lunch) not to exceed \$14.00. No alternate or emergency meals are provided once the limit is reached.
- Snack or a la carte items cannot be charged.
- Elementary and K-8 students will be sent to the office before lunch when the limit is reached.
- Parents/Guardians will continue to receive calls twice weekly as long as they have a negative meal account balance.
