

CRITERIA ACCEPTABLE FOR PROOF OF RESIDENCY:

1. Property Tax statement
2. Rental Property contract, lease, or payment receipt
3. Utility service contract, statement, or payment receipt
4. Pay stub
5. Voter Registration
6. Correspondence from a government agency
7. Deed or closing papers on home purchase
 - a. When deed or closing papers are the only evidence of residency a parent/guardian has to establish residency, a student shall be enrolled/continue enrollment upon receipt of this information. The parent/guardian shall provide a supplemental second proof of residency as soon as one becomes available.
8. Declaration of residency executed by the student's parent/guardian
 - a. A parent/guardian seeking residency status on the basis of his/her employment within district boundaries shall submit proof of the employment which may include, but not limited to, a paycheck stub or letter from the employer listing a physical address within district boundaries. Such evidence shall also indicate the number of hours or days per school week that the parent/guardian is employed at that location.
9. If the student is an unaccompanied youth as defined in 42 USC 11434a, a declaration of residency executed by the student
10. If the student is residing in the home of a caregiving adult within district boundaries, an affidavit executed by the caregiving adult in accordance with Family Code 6552

Homeless/Foster Youth:

However, a homeless or foster youth shall not be required to provide proof of residency as a condition of enrollment in district schools (Ed Code 48852.7, 48853.5, 42 USC 11432).
