The Project Year field is used to distinguish the activities of the same grant with different project years within the fiscal year. In most cases, the grant is a federal one; however, in some instances, state grants have different fiscal years.

For those projects that cross the LEA reporting fiscal year, the project year code is the last digit of the federal fiscal year in which the project terminates. Once the project year is assigned to a project, revenues and expenditures reflect that number.

The Project Year field applies to revenues and expenditures.
